Description:

Uroline is a diuretic, antipyretic and anti-obstructive, the active ingredients of the herbs used in Uroline are betaine, choline, which removes unsaturated bilirubin from the body in a conjugated form with urine, as a result, jaundice gradually improves, in addition, the active ingredients in it relieve pain in the lower abdomen, both sides and below the ribs.

Ingredients: Every 5 ml contains:

<i>Tribulus terrestris</i>	200 mg
<i>Foeniculum vulgare root</i>	50 mg
<i>Foeniculum vulgare</i>	150 mg
<i>Nymphaea alba</i>	150 mg
<i>Citrus aurantium concentrated juice</i>	250 mg
<i>Citric acid</i>	75 mg

Indications: It is effective in bile, dysuria, heat, depression, excessive thirst and restlessness. Uroline is effective in the use of uric acid-releasing drugs such as sulfonamides and antibiotics.

Directions for use: Adults: Take 2-4 teaspoons 3 times a day (with water) after meals | Minors: Take 1-2 teaspoons 3 times a day (with water) after meals or as directed by a doctor.
